Flying the flag carries with it the responsibility to follow the American Flag Rules and Regulations. There are many of these, but the ones that would apply to most Americans are:

- \* If the flag is left up 24 hours a day, it must be illuminated at night.
- \* It is not to be flown in inclement weather.
- \* It should never touch the ground.
- \* When in poor condition, it is to be taken down and properly disposed of by fire. (American Legion posts will take care of the disposal.)
