County Disaster Drill

On Saturday, June 19th, the Santee, El Cajon and La Mesa Fire Departments will hold a disaster drill with the newly formed East County C.E.R.T. Members at New Frontier. The drill will begin at 1:00 PM. A siren will sound to simulate the beginning of an earthquake and the C.E.R.T. Team will go into action. The exercise will last about two hours. Please mark your calendar. There will be volunteers in green vests and emergency vehicles in all areas of the park, as well as observers from a number of agencies.

Reminder

As the days and evenings become warmer it is important to remember to close and lock windows and doors when you are leaving the house for a few days. Install dowels so that windows cannot be opened more than a few inches when retiring for the evening or going out for the day. Lock rear doors when you are entertaining or watching TV in the front of the house. Persons wishing to break in often take the path of least resistance; do not provide them easy opportunities.
