### *Water Meters*

It is getting more difficult to read water meters as vegetation is engulfing a number of meters. Please trim back bushes and trees near the meter location. If you have a fenced yard with a lock you need to arrange access to the meter with the office. Do not use the cabinets containing utility meters for storage and do not stack items in front of the meter cabinets. Thank-you for your cooperation.

### *Reminder*

As the days and evenings become warmer it is important to remember to close and lock windows and doors when you are leaving the house for a few days. Install dowels so that windows cannot be opened more than a few inches when retiring for the evening or going out for the day. Lock rear doors when you are entertaining or watching TV in the front of the house. Persons wishing to break in often take the path of least resistance; do not provide them easy opportunities.

### *Emergency Vehicles*

When the new gates were installed, a new feature was added. Now there is a strobe light opener for fire trucks and ambulances.
