Office Closed

Suspicious Activity

At any time that a suspicious person or suspicious activity is observed in the park, residents should call the Sheriff at the non-emergency number which is 858-565-5200. Call 911 if you feel threatened or in danger.

To reach the New Frontier Staff at any time call 449-1800, 24 hours a day. Please do NOT call park employees at their homes or knock at their doors. The answering service will make the decision who to call if assistance is needed whenever the office is closed. Thank -you for your cooperation.

Pets

The rules state that all pets must be kept on the resident's space and no pets are allowed to roam freely.

It is important that residents not allow pet food to remain out of doors as it attracts stray animals. Stray animals become a nuisance as well as a health hazard to both your own and your neighbor's pet. Pet waste should be picked up daily. Pet owners may NOT pet sit for pets other than their own as this violates the ONE pet per space rule.
