Who to Call

Any time that a suspicious person or suspicious activity is observed in the park, residents should call the Sheriff at the non-emergency number which is 858-565-5200. Call 911 if you feel threatened or in danger.

To reach the New Frontier Staff at any time call **449-1800**, 24 hours a day. Please do NOT call park employees at their homes, cellphones or knock at their doors. The answering service will make the decision who to call if assistance is needed whenever the office is closed. Thank -you for your cooperation.

Power outages need to be reported to SDG&E at 1-800-611-7343. Park staff cannot repair electric lines.

Clean -up

Please take a look at the plants and trees along the front of your home. All plants need to be trimmed back to the gutter and branches on trees need to be high enough for the mail man to easily and safely access the mailbox.

Trim back tree branches that are rubbing against your neighbor's home.

Litter and leaves that have accumulated at driveway ramps need to be picked up.

Check the settings on landscape timeclocks after power outages to verify that the days and times are correct.

Pets
