Office Closed

Guests

Guests may only park in residents' driveways or carports if their vehicle is completely clear of the gutter and not extending into the street. Please ask guests to use the parking provided for their convenience. Street parking is prohibited except to load or unload the vehicles. Contractors should remove needed items and then move their vehicles to the guest parking areas.

Hazardous Waste

Waste Management will accept all manner of hazardous materials for disposal. If you are storing insecticides, paint, oil, gasoline or similar items in your garage you may want to contact Waste Management at 596-5100 to arrange an appointment to dispose of unwanted materials. NEVER pour hazardous materials in the gutters or storm drains ! Gasoline should only be stored in small amounts (1 gallon or less) and must be in approved storage containers.

Water Shortage Notice

The Lake Skinner Treatment Plant is above it's operating capacity which could cause periods when no water would be available. To avoid these interruptions to water service, residents should IMMEDIATELY take the following steps:

1. Skip one weekday of landscape water per week.
2. Only water after 4 PM or before 9 AM.
3. Do not let water run into the street.
4. Check for leaks in your water system.
5. Take short showers and turn off water when brushing teeth or shaving.
6. Wash full loads in dishwasher and clothes washer.

The San Diego Water Authority will make announcements on TV and radio if water interruptions are about to occur.

Dog Walk

It is a good idea to walk with a friend when you go out to walk your dog in the Industrial Park, There are not many people in the vicinity if you should need help after the businesses close at 5 o'clock. Always be aware of your surroundings and avoid suspicious looking persons.

Quiet Time

Each homeowner must maintain radios, record players, television sets and voices at moderate levels between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. daily. The use of power tools and landscape equipment by homeowners or contractors is restricted to the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.. Thank-you for your cooperation.
