Trash pickup will **NOT** be delayed one day for each holiday. Please put out your trash cans on Wednesday, December 28th and Wednesday, January 4th.

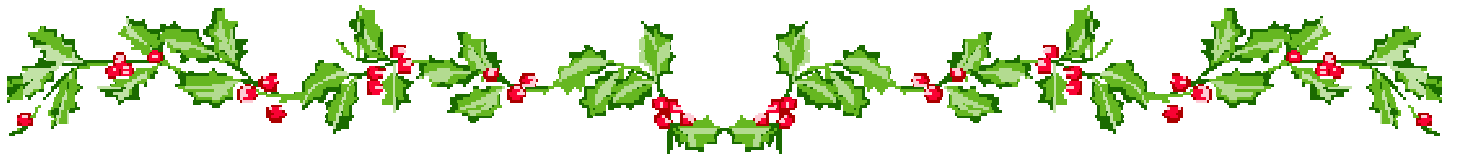
### *And The Winner Is...*
